Essay #9: Synthesis focus on Community chapter: Students will write about the discussion that might ensue among at least five of the writers/artists studied in the Community chapter if those writers were to focus on the following question: What are the characteristics of a productive and successful community at the start of the twenty-first century?

## Tips:

- 1. You can imagine any circumstance you like to have your five chosen ones meet and converse.
- 2. You will have to mix paraphrase and direct quotation to accurately reflect the positions of each writer.
- 3. Setting up this paper as a script makes sense, but you can do it as a narrative if you'd prefer. In either case, make the setting and circumstances clear.
- 4. You want conflict choose your writers such that there will be some argument over the characteristics.
- 5. Have fun with the "non-academic" set up here. You need to be accurate in your representations, but you can play with the writers' conversational responses as long as they are somewhat in character.
- Suggested length as long as it needs to be, but at least 3-4 pages.
