

How to cite the definition of modernism:

How to cite the Hemingway stories using MLA style:

In text, after you have made it clear that you are quoting Hemingway, you would cite the story title. For example:

The line, "A short time after he contracted gonorrhoea from a sales girl in a loop department store while riding in a taxicab through Lincoln Park" is excellent evidence of Hemingway's use of modernist themes of futility and meaninglessness ("A Very Short Story" 96). And then you'd explain how ...

On your Works Cited page, you would arrange the story citations alphabetically by titles. The vignettes would be cited by their non-title titles, "Chapter I" etc. For example:
